Scholarship Details

- Applicants must be seeking a full-time degree or certificate at BRTC and have a GED or high school diploma. Must be a full-time student (12 or more hours).
- Open to current BRTC students, high school graduates, and GED recipients.
- Awarded for one semester only. May reapply for future semesters.
- All applicants selected for scholarship awards will be requested to provide information for publicity purposes.
- The submission of any materials other than those requested will not be considered. Please include only what has been requested and place all materials into a manila envelope labeled with your name.

Required Materials

- Complete Application. Incomplete Applications will not be reviewed.
- High school transcript (with eighth semester & graduation date), GED scores, or most recent college transcript.
- 100-200 word typed essay describing yourself. (ex. ambition, career goals, why you need the scholarship)
- If you have already enrolled for Fall 2009, please attach a copy of your class schedule.

Applicants will be disqualified if they fail to meet the application requirements.
